**The Arms of S.I.M.S.A. Camp
What to Bring to Camp**

Keep this information for your records – do not return with registration

Please check the items off as you pack them. Do not bring your best clothes to camp! We are not responsible for clothing or any items left behind when you return home from camp.

Please bring:

- __ sleeping bag OR 2 warm blankets and sheets
- __ pillow with pillowcase
- __ 2 dry towels and 4 washcloths

Toiletry items:

- __ shampoo & conditioner __ comb __ brush
- __ toothbrush __ toothpaste __ lotion (non-scented/perfumed)
- __ deodorant __ soap __ sunscreen
- __ insect repellent __ shower cap __ sanitary products

- __ 6 to 8 pair of shorts & 3 pair of long pants __ 6 to 8 t-shirts
- __ 6 to 8 pair of underwear __ 6 to 8 pair of socks
- __ 2 pair of pajamas __ raincoat or poncho
- __ 1 bathing suit (**no string/thong bikinis**) __ 1 swimming cap & towel
- __ bandana/cap/sun-visor __ 1 pair of shower shoes
- __ 2 pair of closed shoes (**no sandals/flip flops**) __ 1 pair of hiking/camping boots
- __ lightweight jacket/sweatshirt/hoodie __ flashlight w/extra batteries
- __ Bible __ water bottle
- __ Prescription medications (will be collected and stored with camp Nurse and distributed as prescribed). All meds will be returned at end of camp.

DO NOT BRING...

- Money, Jewelry, or Expensive clothing**
- Electronics**
(cell phones, DSi, I-Pad, MP3 player, etc.)
- Toys (of any kind)**
- Personal Snacks**
- Hair dryers, Curling irons**
or Make-up

No drugs, cigarettes, or alcoholic beverages are permitted. Anyone bringing these items will be sent home at the expense of the campers' family!
